Opening Night June 9<sup>th</sup> 2010 – Stunning Artworks on display in Cardwell by the Sea

**“impressive”-“brilliant”-“wonderful quality of work” – opening night of the Cardwell Art Prize 2010 was full of superlatives.**

Ingham artist, David Rowe was the star of the Cardwell Art Prize 2010 and he certainly had plenty of competition, with artworks of a very high caliber competing for the prizes. All categories were extremely competitive and it was wonderful to see youth artists participating too. The biennial exhibition was opened on Wednesday June 9<sup>th</sup> by Gabrielle Krohn, Chair of the Cardwell & District Community Bank Branch of Bendigo representing the exhibitions major sponsor. In her opening address Gabrielle said, “It has been great to be able to support the schools of our community, the sportspeople and the charities, but I believe it is the artists in a community that define what a community is all about. Historically it is the singers and song writers, the poets and the artists, that through their creativeness, gift to generations to come the historical emotion of the era and that’s what we see here tonight; it’s a great exhibition and it’s more than a lot of great works of art put together, it’s actually the history of now.” Gabrielle congratulated the artists on their work, thanked the community for their support and assured the audience that the community bank was committed to continuing their policy of returning 50% of their profits to the community in support of event just like the Cardwell Art Prize.

Dr Sylvia Ditchburn, a multi award winning artist based in Townsville, traveled to Cardwell to judge the exhibition and attend the award evening at the Cardwell Library & Gallery.

Youth entrants were also well represented in the exhibition with Zazzee Abraham winning first prize in the Primary category and her brother Esen Abraham winning the Special Award. Melanie Robertson was awarded the Mary Henle Youth First Prize in the Secondary Category with Kate Morris receiving the Special Award for this section. All youth entrants also received a participation prize from the Bendigo Bank.

The evening was attended by over 150 art enthusiasts who also took the opportunity to visit the new home of Hinchinbrook Regional Arts Assoc Inc. which has recently relocated the Cardwell Gallery to the historic School of Arts Building in the Library and historic precinct of Cardwell by the Sea.
