
As we planned to visit a water hole on Attie Creek that had some unusual rock formations, and was a 20 minute walk from the road, we changed our usual routine.

'21st Century On Tour'

To mark the end of the first decade of this millennium, the Queensland Art Gallery presents '21st Century: Art in the First Decade' from 18.12.10 to 25.04.11 and will occupy the entire Gallery of Modern Art building, focusing on works created and acquired between 2000 and 2010. It will draw on the Gallery's extensive contemporary collections and also feature outstanding new commissions and a select group of loans from Australian and international lenders. The exhibition will be broad in its geographic and generational scope including more than 80 senior, mid-career and emerging artists from Australia, Asia, the Pacific, Africa, Europe and the Americas. In conjunction an annual Summer Festival for children and families will be held from 13-23 January 2011. Cardwell Gallery will be participating and will conduct a children's art program on Saturday 15.01.11 between 10.30am and 2.30pm at the Cardwell Library. ARTIST PROFILE

JANE ARNOLD



Jane was reared on a dairy farm at Malanda and lived in that area for her first 36 years.

A career change for her husband saw the next four years on a Peninsula cattle station followed by a nine year stint at the mining town of Weipa.

It was here, in 2000, following an unsuccessful attempt to purchase a spoon rest that she came to the conclusion that the only way to get one was to make it herself.

This led to an association and tutelage with well known Weipa and Burdekin potter, Debbie Ferraris.

Since then Jane has developed her own technique in the manufacture of fine functional pottery.

A move to Cardwell in 2004 and the commissioning of her own gas kiln and subsequent experimentation with many glazes has seen the evolution of the unique colours and designs.

Jane derives much pleasure from her attempts to produce attractive, practical and functional pottery and hopes that others gain as much appreciation in the use of the pottery as she achieved in the production.

Jane has taken over as Secretary of the Hinchinbrook Regional Art Gallery and has also taken over the role of Roster Clerk since the Annual General Meeting last year.
