Business arising from Minutes:

The Art Gallery sign situated under the Balliol street sign will be replaced by the Council.

Inward Correspondence.

Libby Clegg – Judge Art Prize feedback, Old Govt. – Amalgamated funding program. Qld Govt. – Grant for lighting awarded.

Outward Correspondence.

2. The problem with the external doors at the library meeting rooms has been reported and the CCRC are looking at it and also the flood lights in front of the Gallery and the big shed.

Judy presented a report on the Art Prize costing. The outcome was that the Gallery had to contribute \$368.55 towards the total cost, thanks to the raffle raising record funds. Thank you to those volunteers who sold tickets in the street, opening night and during the event.

1. Libby Clegg will be holding a printing workshop in August under the HRA Banner. Date to be announced.
2. Advertising for the 2016 Art Prize will be cut down to smaller ads due to the cost.
