The following events are from a program to commemorate 100 years of the ANZAC Spirit throughout 2015 being organised by Mission Arts commencing on 4 April 2015.

### **1 'LEST WE FORGET' Exhibition 4<sup>th</sup> April – 21<sup>st</sup> April 2015**

An exhibition featuring submissions from local artists that reflect an aspect of the war era and of course peace.

Artists, writers and performers will be invited to submit works that reflect the theme of '**Lest We Forget**'. The exhibition will be a celebration of peace. Writers and performers will be given the opportunity to perform their work during the exhibition.

**Sharing Our History:** Supporting the '**Lest We Forget**' theme will be an historical collection of memorabilia from Tully RSL and the local community. Old photographs will be scanned and relevant information recorded such as who is in the photo, what are they doing and who the photo was submitted by. These will be placed on our website and displayed during this and the following exhibition for everyone to look at, and to build a 'local' history of our local and personal connections with conflict.

In remembrance of those Australians killed during the Vietnam conflict, the community will be invited to '**Light a Candle**' for one of the fallen soldiers. Mission Arts will display the photographs of those Australians killed during the conflict and we invite the community to choose a soldier, light a candle, and read a little about their background. Mission Arts will provide the battery operated candles, which will be available for a donation.

### **2 THE ROTARY CLUB MONSTER MARKET COMMUNITY DAY 5<sup>th</sup> April 2015**

To coincide with the '**Lest We Forget**' exhibition, Mission Arts has secured the display of period vehicles used through the war years. We are currently confirming the displays and activities with HAM radio equipment, setting up an old fashioned tea room serving tea and ANZAC biscuits, period clothing parades, Simpson and his donkey, Willeys Jeeps and music from the Army Big Band.

### **3 VOICES FROM THE BATTLEFIELD 4<sup>th</sup> April – 21<sup>st</sup> April**

Will bring to life the words and feelings of men and women serving their country. Letters home, poems and other writings from soldiers will provide a poignant evening as the works are performed and complemented with pieces written by local writers and performers.

Pieces for this evening will be requested to be submitted in conjunction with artwork for the '**Lest We Forget**' exhibition. Some of the writers' pieces may be performed on the opening night.

### **4 CONFLICT ON CELLULOID 4<sup>th</sup> April – 9<sup>th</sup> May**

Presents a carefully selected range of historical and dramatic film archive productions in a series of film nights. Cinema Paradiso has secured the screening rights for three films which will be screened at Mission Arts at 7:00 PM. There will be a bar before and after the screening.
