On Saturday 23 May a wonderful Billy tea and damper morning tea was held to celebrate the resurrection of Sunbeam House (Hubingers Hut). The Cardwell and District Historical Society and a group of volunteers have been working since late 2013 to rebuild the hut after receiving a grant from Newmans Own Foundation.

Roy Jorgenson, our lead builder and site manager, has done a marvellous job working with our volunteers. As much as possible of the original timber was used, however the society also received very welcome donations from local businesses and locals who donated steel rods, old iron, posts and sawn timber for the job. Some weather boards from the demolished J.C. Hubinger Museum in town were also used.

A large crowd was there, including visitors from Brisbane to the Tablelands. Our trumpeter excelled himself and volunteers and donors were presented with a framed photo of the completed hut.

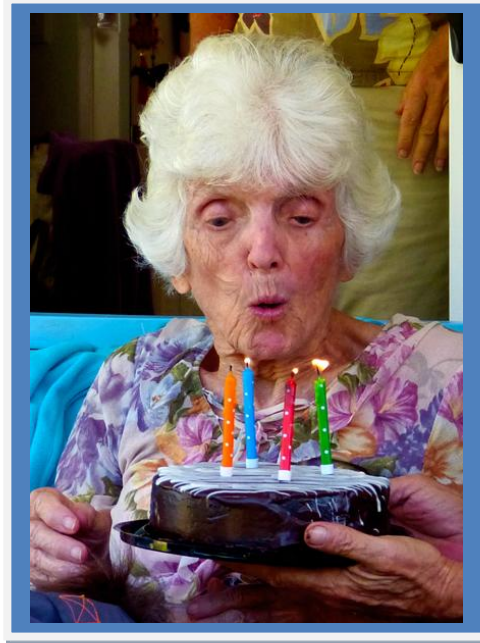

This exhibition was a great success for Jessica Roelofs (HRA President) and the team of senior students involved.

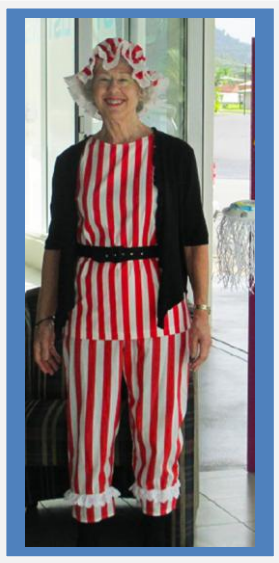
# Congratulations Margaret!



HRA member Margaret Thorsborne AO celebrated her 88<sup>th</sup> birthday in June

2015 is a very special year for Margaret as she also will be celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> year of the Brook Isles Torresian Imperial Pigeon Count that she and her late husband, Arthur began in 1965. It is now the longest running data study of any bird species in Australia – a tremendous achievement.

In recent months Margaret has been busily working with a film crew and documentary maker Sarah Scraggs to tell the story of the count. The documentary has been assisted by a RADF grant and will be released later this year.
