ENTRIES NOW OPEN: 2013 Queensland Regional Art Awards

Regional and remote visual artists can win over \$15000 in prizes and be selected for a Queensland touring exhibition by entering the 2013 Queensland Regional Art Awards. The QRAA is an annual visual arts prize and exhibition for established and emerging artists living in regional and remote Queensland. This year artists are asked to respond to the theme 'Living Change'. The Awards program aims to highlight the wealth of creative talent located outside the capital city and provide a platform for further professional development.

Main prizes offered in 2013 are:

- Wayne Kratzmann Art Prize - \$10,000 plus 2 week Brisbane residency (acquisitive)
- Flying Arts Young Artist Development Award - \$1500 (non acquisitive)
- Art Shed- Brisbane People's Choice Award - \$750 art materials
- The Edge Digital Art Award - 2 week fully funded residency at The Edge #
- TAFTA Textile Award - part scholarship to annual TAFTA forum +

All entries will be featured in the QRAA Online Gallery and will be eligible for the Art Shed Brisbane People's Choice Award. Head judge and curator Tim Morrell and the judging panel will view all entries, select the prize winners and shortlist artworks to include in the touring exhibition.

ARTIST PROFILE

KERRY ROBERTSON



Kerry has lived in North Queensland most of her life but has enjoyed travelling and reading about other places. This has proved to be an important factor in the way she views the colour of her environment and surroundings.

Kerry started quite young drawing and making collages and other crafts when immobilised with a broken leg. This led to art classes with Anneke Silver where she learnt a lot about oil painting and drawing. After high school Kerry moved on to other art forms and became involved with Fibres and Fabrics when it was first formed.

Always moving forward (sometimes jumping all over the place), Kerry has progressed through, read and studied and occasionally taught in a wide range of techniques including Spinning and Weaving; Tapestry Weaving; Batik; Paper making; Printing (mostly screen printing and etching); Basketry; Silk Painting; Embroidery techniques including Brazilian, Elizabethan, Crewel, Tapestry, Silk Ribbon, Needle Art; Beading and combinations in three dimensional work.

Kerry stated that while working ideas can come from anywhere and everywhere, sometimes it is an external source that makes you want to create an image and other times it is the opposite in that the technique leads her to a creation. Either way it is always producing something of comfort to release the colour, movement, repetition and feeling of the environment around us.

As time goes by Kerry thinks it is more and more important just to stop and take time to smell the roses and her art is produced with the philosophy in that a lot is hand stitched, the repetition is often comforting both internally for her and externally for the viewer especially her family and friends.
